## INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

STEP 1: Print out your files and cut the Roll A Feast game board sheets in half.

STEP 2: Give each player a game board sheet.

STEP 3: Gather game board markers (see list below).

STEP 4: Give each player some game board markers.

## HOW TO PLAY:

Taking turns, each player must roll one die, and all players place a marker on the corresponding number on the board. First player to roll their entire feast, by having all 12 markers filled, wins!

## SUPPLIES YOU'LL NEED TO GATHER:

- Game Board Markers - candy corns, marshmallows, M&M's, raisins, etc work great!
- One die.



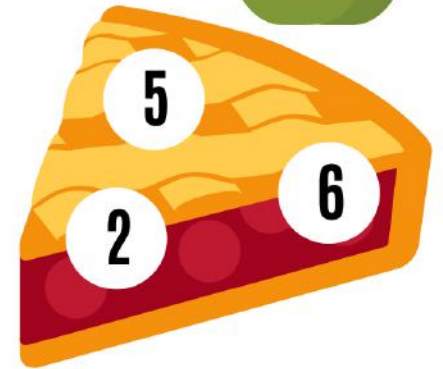
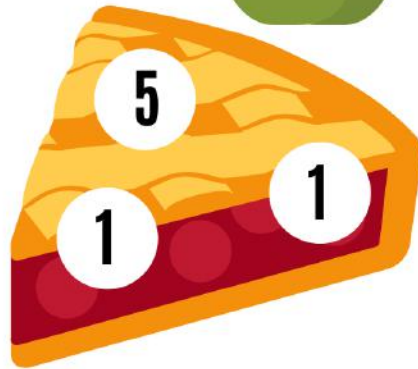
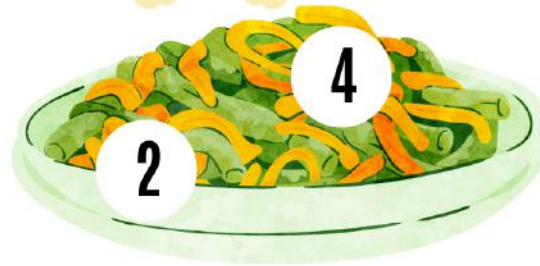
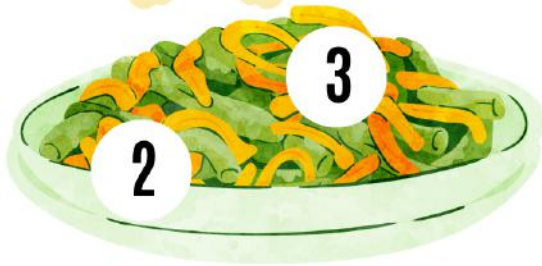
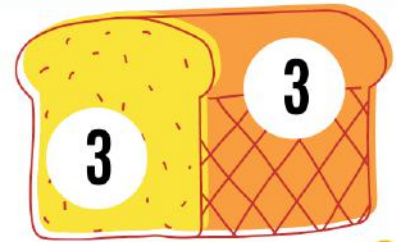
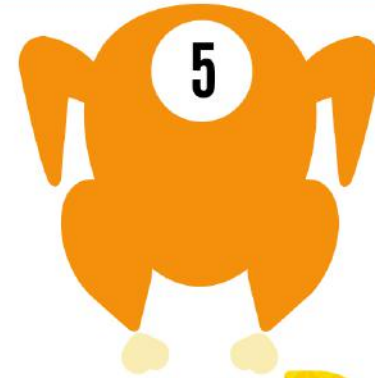
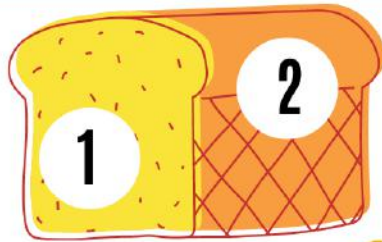
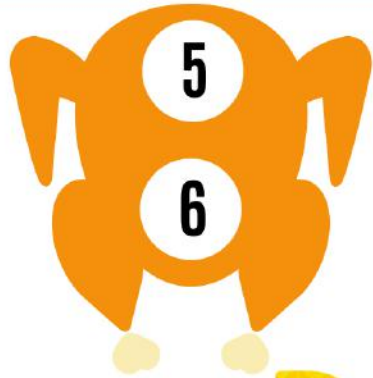
